ORDINANCE NO. 02020-16

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO AFFIRM THAT ANY FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT SHALL BE EXPENDED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT

WHEREAS, Ohio Senate Bill 310 was passed on May 7, 2020 and creating a mechanism for the State of Ohio to distribute federal financial aid to Ohio's local governments below 5000,000 in population as provided by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security ("CARES") Act; and

WHEREAS, The City of Gallipolis, Ohio, wishes to affirm that the City will follow the guidelines established by the U.S. Department of Treasury on how the federal aid can be spent; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Senate Bill 310 imposes certain requirements on local governments to affirm that the funds so received will be expended only to cover costs of the subdivision consistent with the requirements of section 5001 of the CARES Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 601(d). Certified copies of this legislation must be submitted to the County Auditor and the Ohio Office of Budget and Management; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: Any funds received by the City of Gallipolis, Ohio in accordance with Ohio Senate Bill 310 and the CARES Act may be expended only to cover costs of the subdivision consistent with the requirements of section 5001 of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 601(d), and any applicable regulations.

SECTION 2: The City of Gallipolis, upon receiving a CARES Act payment shall report to the office of Budget and Management, upon request, information related to the expenditure of those funds.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon passage as an emergency measure.
